



Justification de l'évaluation : The candidate's answer is satisfactory for a CEFR level A2. It uses simple sentences with basic conjunctions and expresses personal preferences clearly.

Pertinence de la réponse : The answer is relevant to the question as it directly addresses the favorite holiday, Christmas, and provides reasons related to family, friends, music, food, gifts, and snow.

4. Analyse des réponses

Question

I just read "What she left behind" and it really stayed with me. It's about a young woman falsely admitted into an insane asylum, and her whole experience there. Justification de l'évaluation : The candidate's answer is satisfactory for a CEFR level B1. It includes full sentences with verbs and provides a clear description of the books that made an impression. The language used is appropriate for this level.

Pertinence de la réponse : The answer is relevant as it directly addresses the question by discussing two books that left a strong impression on the candidate, providing reasons why they were impactful.

Justification de l'évaluation : The candidate's answer demonstrates a good understanding of the topic and uses full sentences with verbs, which is expected at a B2 level. However, there are minor grammatical issues that slightly affect the overall quality.

Pertinence de la réponse : The answer is relevant to the question as it discusses consumption habits and their impact on the planet, aligning with environmental concerns implied in the question.

Justification de l'évaluation : The candidate's answer is coherent and demonstrates an understanding of the topic, which aligns with B2 level expectations. However, it lacks full sentences for each point made.

Justification de l'évaluation : The answer is brief and lacks depth in discussing both convergence and divergence perspectives of globalization's impact on culture, which is expected at a C1 level.

Pertinence de la réponse : The candidate touches on the concept of cultural erasure due to globalization but does not sufficiently address both convergence and divergence as outlined in the reference document. The response lacks detailed analysis or examples, making it only partially relevant.

Pertinence de la réponse : The answer correctly identifies key points from the reference document, such as serving international customers better, expanding business internationally, and collaborating with diverse backgrounds. It aligns well with the information provided in the text.

Pertinence de la réponse : The candidate's answer aligns well with the reference document, highlighting cultural understanding and expanding social connections as benefits of multilingualism. However, it could be more specific about speaking three or more languages.

Justification de l'évaluation : The candidate's answer is concise and addresses both positive and negative impacts of social media on mental health, using relevant examples. However, it lacks depth expected at a C1 level.

Pertinence de la réponse : The answer correctly identifies the positive aspects such as support and mood elevation, as well as negatives like blue light exposure and cyberbullying. It aligns with the reference document but could include more detail for a fuller response.

Justification de l'évaluation : The candidate's answer is relevant to the audio content but contains a spelling mistake and lacks a verb, which affects its grammatical correctness.

Pertinence de la réponse : The answer correctly identifies examples of legislative measures related to sustainability as mentioned in the audio file. However, it does not include a verb in the sentence structure as required by the question.

Justification de l'évaluation : The candidate's answer is mostly satisfactory for a B1 level as it includes a full sentence with verbs and addresses the question. However, the response could be more detailed to fully align with B1 expectations.

Pertinence de la réponse : The answer is relevant and correct according to the audio file content. It mentions discussing a chosen book, sharing opinions, and talking about characters, which aligns well with what was described in the recording.

Justification de l'évaluation : The candidate's answer is partially satisfactory for a B2 level. It includes a verb and addresses part of the audio content, but it lacks completeness and detail expected at this level.

Pertinence de la réponse : The answer is relevant as it mentions selecting high-quality loose tea leaves and using filtered water, which are steps mentioned in the audio file. However, it omits other important details such as heating the water to an appropriate temperature or steeping time.

They are just these incredible mountains. They're so high. They're so beautiful. They're just such a powerful show of nature and of the strength of nature. I felt really humble walking around the Alps. Switzerland is a beautiful country. It's very clean. It's very well-maintained. It's also, unfortunately, extremely expensive, so that was the impact that it had on me. I no longer have any money left. If I could visit any place in the world right now, I think it would be Greece. It's a country that my family and I really would like to go to because of the architectures from centuries ago, like the Parthenon and things like that. I also would very much like to visit Iceland. It's a country that has always attracted me because of its nature, because of its relief, because of its water, because of its birds, because of just how wonderful it looks from everything that I've seen. I would really, really love to visit Iceland.

Answer Analysis

Score rationale: The candidate's answer is satisfactory for a CEFR level B1. The response is clear and coherent, with appropriate vocabulary and sentence structures for this level.

Relevance of the answer: The answer is relevant to the question as it describes a memorable trip to Switzerland, its impact on the candidate, and also mentions places they would like to visit in the future, such as Greece and Iceland.

15. Analyse des réponses

Explain the importance of a healthy work-life balance. What strategies can individuals use to maintain this balance?

Transcription de la réponse du candidat

Work-life balance can be something that's very difficult to achieve for some people. I think it depends on where you live to, which country you live in, what job you have, obviously, and your personality. This is France, and I feel like a lot of people make a great effort here in not overarching and letting you have your own time, your free time, weekends are weekends, they're real. Same with holidays and evenings. I used to live in the U.S., and it was quite a different story. I felt like people just lived to work, and they didn't work to live. And I didn't like that. My work is what I do, not who I am, and so I'm very happy to have moved back to France where I can be myself. I love my job, I absolutely love my job, but it's not everything that I am or that I can be. Some of my strategies, I would say, are to have a good transition between work and home. To me, that's one of the most important things. If I work from home, it's very difficult because I just step out of my office and there I am with my family and my house and my chores and my bills and everything, and it's very difficult to transition. But when I actually go to work, I either bike or take the tram or walk or sometimes drive, and at least that provides me with transition time. And it's very, very nice to be able to go from one to the other without jumping into it too fast. So for me, that's the main thing, to have them very, very separate and even take the time to have that separation, not to go from one to the other too quickly.

Answer Analysis

Score rationale: The candidate provides a detailed answer with personal experiences and strategies, demonstrating an understanding of work-life balance. The response is coherent and mostly grammatically correct, fitting the B2 level requirements.

Number of grammar mistakes: 3

Relevance of the answer: The answer is relevant as it addresses both the importance of work-life balance and personal strategies to maintain it. The candidate uses examples from different countries to illustrate their point, which aligns well with the question's context.

Transcription de la réponse du candidat

Okay, this is going to be a really difficult question for me because I really don't like sports and I don't care about them at all. So I would have to answer individual because the only type of sport that I practice is individual. I run, I try to run on a regular basis, I walk, I have a cross trainer at home if you can consider that a sport. I just feel very uncomfortable in a team sports situation personally, I was probably traumatized at school, I was never picked, I don't have very good synchronicity, I don't have very good reflexes, I don't have good mobility. So all those things were important at school when learning team sports and being chosen. And when you are the only one who's always last to be chosen to be in a team, whether it be, I don't know, handball, volleyball, basketball, and nobody ever picks you or they pick you because they absolutely have to because there's nobody left, it leaves a mark on you. So I swore as an adult that I would never practice a team sport because it would be too painful for me to be brought back into that context. But I can see how it would provide, it would definitely provide team spirit, it helps you with team building, to be able to manage a team is a very good skill to have in life, to listen to people, team spirit is important, but I think I can develop that in a work team as opposed to a sports team.

Answer Analysis

Score rationale: The candidate's response is coherent and detailed, demonstrating a strong command of English vocabulary and structure typical of C1 level. The answer is slightly longer than expected but remains relevant.

Relevance of the answer: The candidate's answer is relevant as it addresses the question by explaining their preference for individual sports over team sports, supported by personal experiences and reflections on both types.

17. Analyse des réponses

Why is advertising often criticised? Please justify your answer.

Transcription de la réponse du candidat

Advertising is an interesting thing. I think it has changed, actually, in the past 170 years or so. Because it used to be that you would have a bunch of old white men sitting in an office, deciding how things should be marketed, what impact certain pictures, certain images, certain words could have on people. And now I feel like it's being democratized, or more than that, it's being changed entirely. Because now advertising is what? You're watching a video on YouTube and suddenly, out of nowhere, the person who is making the video is advertising a VPN or, I don't know, software on this computer or an app or something. So it's totally, totally different, because it's not like the advertisements that are in between movies or even during movies or TV shows on TV. There's a lot of money that's being used to make commercials and make advertisements, especially in the US. And I feel like people don't watch them anymore, because a lot of people stream. You go on Netflix or on Prime Video and all that, and you don't see ads anymore. So why is that money being spent? So now they've resorted to doing things differently. For example, YouTube did not used to have advertising, and now it does. So if you don't want to suffer, because I would consider that suffering, then you have to pay for YouTube premium, which is what I do, so I don't have to see commercials. But it's changed. Now it's in the middle of a two-minute video, you have advertising. So I think for all those reasons, it's heavily criticized, because it interrupts the flow of what you're doing. You can't even watch a video. It's forcing you to consume. And I think that is the worst possible thing about it, that you should be able to buy whatever you want without being forced, without having somebody telling you, oh, you need this or you need to buy this. No, you don't. You should be able to do whatever it is that you want to do. So I think advertising is like lobotomy.

Answer Analysis

Score rationale: The candidate demonstrates a strong command of English, with complex structures and vocabulary typical of C2 level. However, the answer is lengthy and somewhat digresses from directly addressing the criticism aspect.

Number of grammar mistakes: 1

Relevance of the answer: The candidate's answer touches on criticisms of advertising but focuses more on its evolution rather than explicitly detailing why it is criticized. The relevance could be improved by focusing more on specific criticisms such as consumer manipulation or privacy concerns.

Yes, yes it does. I'm much happier talking about music than I am talking about sports. I grew up listening to music. I don't know, it's something that I did very early on, maybe starting at seven or eight years old. I had records in my room, then I went to tapes, then CDs, then of course now streaming. But everything I did, I had a Walkman very early on. I would ride my bike to go to school and listen to music on my bike. When I was going to college, riding the bus, riding public transport, I would always, always, always have music playing. Of course now when I travel, when I work out, even when I do dishes, music has always been a huge, huge part of my life. It helps me cope, I think, a lot of the times. I married a musician, he's a pianist, and so I hear piano being played live in my living room every single day of my life. So I don't think life without music is possible in my life. I think it encourages the mood that we're on, it can make you sadder if you're already sad, it can certainly make you happier. So I think it's an integral part of my life and I wanted to continue being that way, for sure, because it's not something that I feel I can live without. I've tried to learn how to play an instrument, which unfortunately I was not able to do. I tried piano for a few months, I tried the auto harp, which is kind of weird. I even tried a saxophone, but I think I'm too old. But my daughter is a singer, she plays the guitar and the ukulele. My husband's a pianist, like I said. My son plays the piano as well. So music is definitely a very important aspect of my family life.

Answer Analysis

Score rationale: The candidate provides a detailed and coherent response, demonstrating a strong command of the language typical of C1 level. The answer is well-structured and uses varied vocabulary.

Number of grammar mistakes: 2

Relevance of the answer: The answer is highly relevant as it clearly addresses the question by explaining how music plays an important role in the candidate's life, providing personal anecdotes and examples to justify their viewpoint.
